



## **English for International Students**

Erasmus and other international students are welcome to register for English courses at the Language Centre (Sprachenzentrum). Enrollment (Anmeldung) for language courses via <u>CMIIfe</u>

NOTE: You will only be able to register for Anglistik (Sprachpraxis) courses (e.g. Grammar, Academic Writing I) if you are enrolled on an Anglistik (Anglophone Studies) programme. Registration for these courses opens on 14 April (10 a.m.)

If you are officially registered on the Bachelor programme in Betriebswirtschaftlslehre, Economics, Wirtschaftsingenieurwesen, Gesundheitsökonomie or Sportökonomie you can sign up (without a Placement Test) for SE060 Business English I via CMlife on 14 April (8 a.m.)

In order to register for C1 level courses (EAP II/UNIcert III) you must first take a placement test (Einstufungstest) (on 16 / 17 / 23 / 24 April) or be exempted from the test. Registration for the placement test opens in <u>CMlife</u> on 7 April. Full details together with information on how to apply for an exemption from the test: <u>Placement Test</u>

You do NOT need to take a placement test for ICC and/or EAP I courses - cf. below.

All English courses are 2 SWS courses = 2 hours per week during the semester
